

GDPR & Security Overview

Smart Student Sorter is designed to minimise data risk for schools by processing pupil data locally within the browser rather than transferring it to external servers.

How pupil data is handled

- Pupil data is processed locally within the browser on the school's device.
- Pupil data is not uploaded to Edatech servers.
- We do not have access to the files schools analyse.
- The application does not intentionally persist pupil data between sessions.
- Schools may optionally download generated outputs for their own records.

What Edatech stores

- Account information such as email address and billing records.
- Licensing and subscription information required to operate the service.
- We do not store uploaded pupil datasets.

Network & infrastructure

- The application loads securely over HTTPS.
- Once loaded, sorting operations take place locally within the browser.
- Schools with restrictive firewalls can request a list of required domains.

Roles & responsibilities

Schools remain responsible for their own pupil data and GDPR obligations. Because pupil data is processed locally and is not transferred to our servers, Edatech does not ordinarily act as a processor of pupil data when the product is used as designed.

DPIA Support Summary

Many schools choose to complete a DPIA for all new software products. The following points are intended to support school data protection reviews.

Category	Summary
Type of processing	Local browser-based pupil data sorting and organisation
Data transferred to Edtech	None
Special category data	Should only be used in accordance with school policies
Retention	No intentional persistence of pupil data by the application
Access to data	Edtech cannot access uploaded datasets
Security measures	HTTPS delivery, local processing architecture
School controls	Schools control downloaded outputs and local retention

Recommended wording for schools

"Pupil data is processed locally within the browser and is not transmitted to external servers. The supplier does not have access to uploaded datasets. Downloaded outputs are retained according to the school's own storage and retention policies."
